**All Food Vendor spots are \$150.**

Vendor spots will be first come first

served, meaning the first to get money and application turned in will be considered according to available space, power needs and variety of products. We cannot accept applications and fees from five frozen banana booths, so please understand.

- Allotted vendor space is a 12x12 area. Vendors supply tables, chairs and tent.
- The event will go on rain or shine.
- Vendor Fee: \$150 for booth space (non-refundable). *Make checks payable to CCH Historical Society. Mail to PO Box 807, Charleston, TN 37310 or drop off to the Hiwassee River Heritage Center, Tuesday – Friday, 11-5, Saturday, 11-3.*
- Deadline for reservations is August 15.
- Power access is limited. Note your need for power on the form below. Power is on “first come, first served” basis. **You will not be allowed to use outlets assigned to other vendors.**
- All Vendors must be set up and ready for business by 10 a.m. All vehicles should be moved to designated vendor parking **no later** than 9 a.m. Unload, move car, then set up. Security will be present Friday overnight. Friday set up is between 2-6 p.m. and is ENCOURAGED.
- Vendors must remain set up for the duration of the festival. Vendors who tear down prior to 7:30 p.m. may not be invited to future festivals.
- **Cowpea Festival staff reserves the right to limit the number of vendors selling the same items.** Too much of the same thing makes no one HAPPEA.
- Placement of booth locations will be adjusted this year for appropriate spacing due to Covid-19 crowd control. This will limit the number of spots with electricity by about half. We **cannot** take requests for specific spots. **All spots will be great!**
- The Cowpea Festival and Cook-off coordinators, volunteers and sponsors will not be held responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property of any kind. Secure your own space and goods.
- To keep the festival grounds pleasant and presentable, all Vendors are required to keep their space clean and free of trash of any kind. Trash containers will be provided throughout the festival.
- In keeping with community values of Charleston and image of the Cowpea Festival and Cook-off, the festival committee reserves the right to take down any display of objectionable material or remove Vendors whose conduct is disruptive. No refund is provided if Vendor or content is removed from the event due to violation of this agreement.
